Here are 3 Ways in which you can accomplish this:

Individuals who have been a legal permanent resident for at least five years (three if married to a U.S. citizen) should determine their eligibility and consider whether now is the time to become a U.S. citizen. If you are ready to take the next step, fill out an N-400 form and start your naturalization process today!

If you are a U.S. citizen and eligible to register to vote, do so today and make your voice heard in 2020!

Protect your community's access to fair political representation and critical funding for healthcare, education and transportation programs by making sure you are counted in the 2020 Census!
